MINUTES OF SESSION.

Genedale Hamilton Co. Ohio Nov. 29th 1855

On the evening of the above date according to previous appointment a meeting was held in the Chapel of Genedale Female College for the purpose of organizing a Presbyterian Church. Rev. John Covert & Rev. Thomas Spencer of the Presbytery of Hamilton (New School) being present organized a church.

The following persons being present presented letters of dismission and were organized into a church under the name and style of "The First Presbyterian Church of Genedale" viz Leok Rive, Caroline Rink, Priscilla Kitchell, Harriet Stamb, L. C. Covert, Louisa Frihoff and Elvira Spencer from the Church of College Hill Ohio J. J. Packer, Catherine Packer & Sherman Denton from Mt Pleasant Ohio Henry Bishoprick & Elizabeth Bishoprick from the Tabernacle Church Cin. Harriet Bartlett from the 2nd Church Madison Ind. Elizabeth Graves from Lockland Pres. Church Ohio Emma F. White, Central Ch. Crawfordsville Ind. Malvina Shanklin Greensville Ind & E. D. Babbitt.
